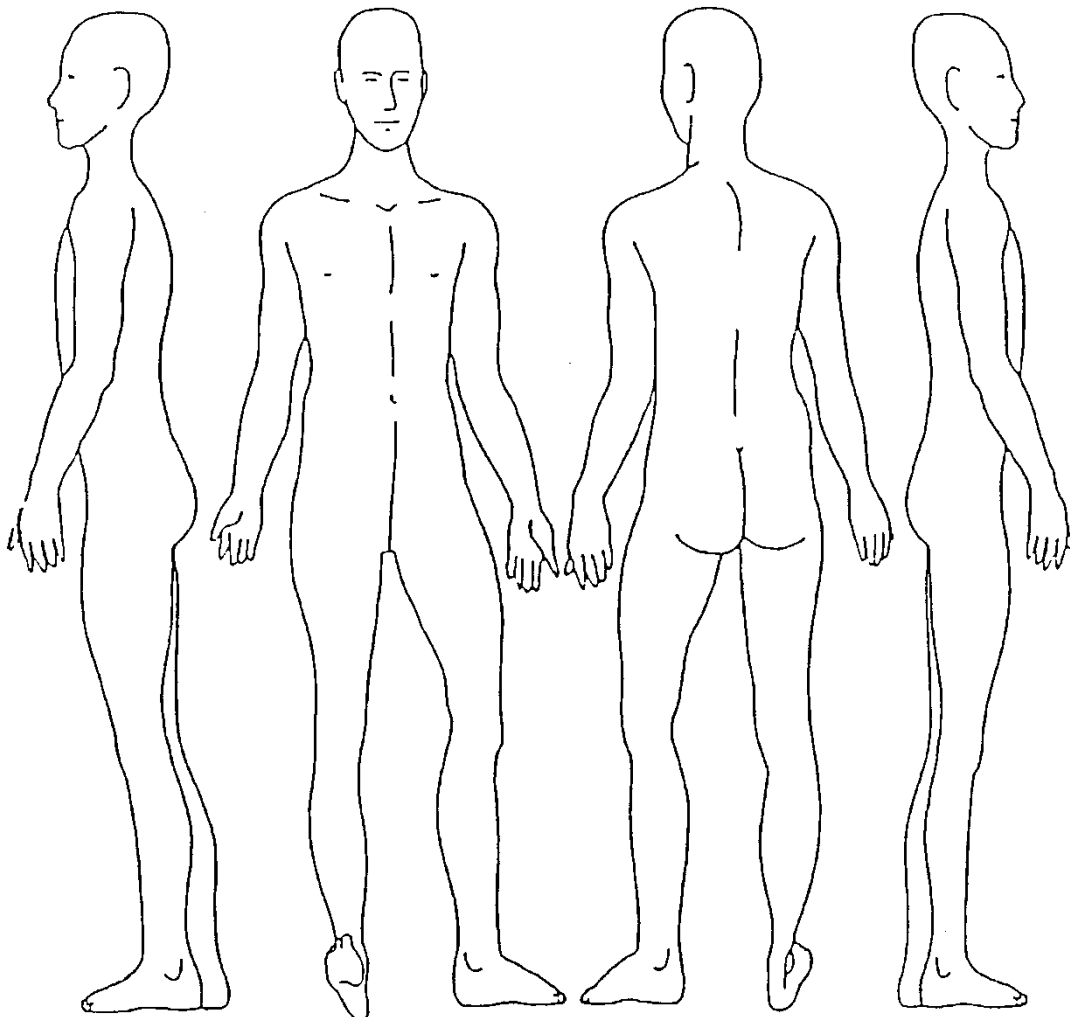

- Data protection should be adhered to including consideration of safe storage.
- Physical injuries must be reported to the Police; and
- Where forensic evidence is required a Police Photographer should take the photo.
